Part A:

The Local IQAC has prepared the action plan to strengthen quality and to receive results during the academic year 2009-2010 to consider over the next objectives:

To follow the objectives shown in part 'C' of the AQAR (2008-2009).

To maintain social awareness with superb care for the extension activities organized by the college.

To support guest lectures, workshops, seminars, group discussions on eminent themes and issues stressing the social and educational purposes.

Women's Hostel:

The Women's Hostel has been a feeding support to the Women's education in the area of the Muktainagar Taluka & in the surrounding area of the other Talukas. As a beginning, we have admitted 20 girls to the Hostel on the second floor of the college building. Prof. Panchashila Waghmare, Lecturer in English has been assigned the responsibilities relating the girls-students.

Center for coaching for Competitive Examination:

If Student is inspired, the Institution travels to the social commitments. To try to fulfill the social needs, the college holds the classes on the competitive examination and it becomes the primary preparation and the continuing promotion to the examination of

M.P.S.C. and U.P.S.C. Guest lectures and workshops are engaged on the basis of the competitive coaching, as a result, many of the students of the college have been influenced to seek admission to the Competitive Classes at Jalgaon and Pune. Some of them have sought positions as ideal ones in the life of society.

The college supplies the students the multi subjects-books to shape their characters to the substantial build. The General Knowledge Committee runs the General-Knowledge Classes as per Schedule to face the General-Knowledge Examination of the University.

Personality Development:

Muktainagar Taluka still is undeveloped in this globalised world. As its effect, maximum of the students remain weak and disabled in the skill of writing and speaking English. Such students run to the college to seek English as a special subject and hence it becomes very difficult to the English teachers to take out result as per the expectation of the Institution, hence, the English department engages Extra lectures on the Communication-Skill completing the workload in the schedule and turns them to be the successful students. It is not exaggeration that the disabled students climb up to the summit of their success but this has been the main aid to the growth of the students to the English Department. The extra periods on the University prescribed syllabus also are engaged in the afternoon completing the workload to try the best results in the Annual Examination. Other departments also mould their students to set them best in the subjects related, hence, students are satisfied with the teaching of all the departments due the personality-development efforts of the departments. Principal, Dr. R.H.Gupta and the Institution have been inspiring to the stakeholders of the college. It has been the developing step of the Institution to the college staff and the students. All the departments have brought the results up to 80% and seen their students developed towards the personality. Maximum of the subjects show 100% of result in the University Examination.

Department of English engages the English Speaking Classes on Writing Speaking Skills to develop the personality of Students. Listening, Reading and Communication are also practiced to solve the English problems to face the globalized issues in future. Hence most of the students of the Department of English have secured

the safety jobs in the educational field. They are also working in the communication sections of the famous companies like IBM, Infosys and Airtel. Ganesh Bore and Rajesh Jadhav have been running their private tuition firms at Bhusawal and Sangamner in the state of Maharashtra successfully. Dipesh Wankhede is doing his M.B.A. at the college of technology, London, U.K. through the Merit Scholarship of Rs 25 lacs sanctioned by the Government of Maharashtra. He has to complete the course within the span of 16 months. It has been very appreciating in the area because he has been only one in the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

The Department of English implements the projects on syllabus, home-assignments, group-discussions, seminars, etc and this becomes the inspiration to the students to be admitted to the department. Thus the Department has been the biggest department in the college due to the practice of the Communication-Skills, and the continuous extra-periods, being the students disabled in education.

The Department of commerce has been running the Career Oriented Courses successfully, and hence, the flow of students' strength has been attracted. The teachers have been teaching the syllabi honestly, therefore, the enthusiasm among the students has been true to be appreciated.

The Department of Economics, the Departments of Marathi, General Hindi, the Department of Political Science and the Departments of Social Sciences have been at keen care sincerely in teaching the syllabi, so, they have been collecting the attractive results from their students.

It should be admitted Dr R.H.Gupta, former Registrar of the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and our present Principal has been paying sincere attention and maintaining distinct discipline at all the levels of the teaching of and hence, the departments have sought good results. The General Knowledge Committee carried out the lectures of the experts on the various corners of the General Knowledge in order to develop the personalities of students that they will face the Competitive Examinations.

The Counseling Centre, the Yuvati Sabha, the Alumni, the Departmental Associations, the Gandhi Peace Centre, the Physical Education, the Environmental Science, etc. followed their activities with enthusiasm and tried to develop the students' personalities. The Educational Trips, the Nature-Visits, the Practical Framing Activities were also organized by the departments to shape students' personalities. The former students were invited for guidance from time to time that the learning students will follow and bring developments to their lives. Various sports were practiced by the students. The students were taught how to labour for themselves and for society through the labour activities of the Earn and Learn Scheme. Health Awareness was given to the students through Environmental Field-Work. Social and natural survey was made through the Educational Trips. The spirit of industrious works was kindled among the students through the Industrial Visits.

Enrichment of Library:

Library makes students well acquainted with the world-issues. Hence, our Principal, Dr. R. H. Gupta, tried to enrich the library to be fruitful for reading the complete world. The library has been modernized through his honest care.

The library purchased 335 books of Rs 50,856/- during this year. There are now 10541 books in the library including encyclopedias, dictionaries, general knowledge-

books, books on earth, environmental books, the textual and referential books connected with the knowledge of Arts and Commerce. There are also the religious books and the books on the social reformers. The Principal has stressed on the books of the General-Knowledge.

The library has 54 magazines on various subjects department-wise. The college has purchased the reputed journals national and international. Thus, Rs 34,085/- have been spent to purchase these books and the journals. 11 News papers in Marathi, Hindi and English have been made available for the stakeholders. A separate reading-cell is there for the reading. The needs of the students and the teaching-staff are fulfilled with the books. The former students also avail the books for their own purpose. The Principal has been trying to make the library well-furnished to notice the issues of the global era.

Promotion of Research:

Teachers and students have no value without promotion of research. They are put moving with the researches new. The innovative strategies are carried out through the Nature Visit, the Industrial Visit, the Environmental Science Field-Work, the Educational Trip, etc. from time to time to make them known to the research activity.

The Principal, Dr. R. H Gupta has been giving importance to the activity of the research like Essay Writing, the Project Preparing, & the Group Discussion to promote the eye of research among the students. All the Departments give projects to their students during the year.

The Principal, being a renowned M. Phil and Ph.D. Guide, holds up all the times the promotion of Research. There is no such a meeting, in which, he hasn't recalled the significance of the Research and instructed the teaching-staff for having interest in the Research Activity. Therefore, the teachers have attempted and presented their Research Papers at State National and International levels. Some of them have been lucky to get their papers published at the national and the International levels.

Prof. V.S. Jadhav, Physical Education Director, is working on his Ph. D. in North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Prof. S. D. Patil of the Department of Geography is also working on Ph. D. Prof. Vandana Lavhale and Prof. S. A. Saindane has sought the exemption-letters to get their names registered for the Ph. D. Dr. J. B More, Head,

Department of Commerce is the Ph. D. and M. Phil guide in the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Without books, research cannot be Possible' hence, the Principal and the Institution have emphasized more on the availability of different books in the library.

Part B:-

1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:-

The college always tried to flourish students' personalities. The attempts have been made honestly to change students in to ideal citizens to contribute to the Nation building. The outside associations were permitted to take their programmes in the college, so, the students were identified with the social manners through such programmes. They were made gradually silent to know their duties towards themselves and towards the Nation.

Communication in English takes students to the National and the International levels. Therefore, the Writing and the Speaking-skills of the students have been tested through the extra-periods on the communication skill. Prof, L.B. Gayakawad, Head, Department of English engaged the extra-periods on the Writing and the Speaking Skills continuously. The guest lectures on the Personality Development were organized from time to time. Now, the college has sent a proposal to the U.G.C. to start Career Oriented Course in English to build the communication skills of the students.

The Career Oriented Courses in Banking, Taxation, Accountancy and Auditing have been run successfully by the Department of Commerce. The College ground was given to the societal agencies to utilize for their cultural and social activities, which were entertained by the students and the teachers of the college. Boys from society utilized the ground for their sports and exercises. People came on the ground to do their morning and evening exercises. All the persons of the college cared the ground with their honest capacity. The College Organized the Annual Social Gathering of 2 days on the ground. The students performed their roles in the different arts and turned to the social awareness. It was our attempt to follow the goals and the objectives of the Institution.

All the college activities are undertaken in the Multi-Purpose Hall. This Hall goes always to decorate the personalities of the students and the teachers. The Primary School of the Zilla Parishad, Jalgaon conducted their Scholarship Examination and their Meeting in the Multi-Purpose Hall and the rooms adjacent.

The Nature Club, the General Knowledge Committee, the Departmental Association, the Adult-Education and Extension Services, the N.S.S. Department, the Yuvati Sabha, the Counseling Centre, the Students' Friendship Group and the Workshops carry out their related activities in the Multi-Purpose Hall. The Prize Distributions of the college and the High School are celebrated in the Hall. Thus, the Multi-Purpose Hall is used to brighten the hidden corners of the students to contribute to the Nation's building as per the goals and the objectives of the Institution.

2) New Academic Programmes Initiated (UG and PG):

- a) The Classes of M.Com. are being run successfully by the Department of Commerce.
- b) The Classes of M.A. in Economics have been started since 2009-10 and they are engaged regularly by the Department of Economics.
- c) The Career Oriented Courses in F.Y.B.COM. in the subjects of, "Banking, Taxation, Auditing and Accountancy are being engaged successfully by the Department of Commerce.
- d) The College has sent the proposal of the Career Oriented Course in "Speak English with Grammar and Phonology" to UGC to develop the Communication-Skills of the students who are disabled in writing and speaking being Muktainagar Taluka educationally and economically backward. Prof. L.B. Gayakwad, Head, Department. of

English engaged the Remedial Classes on Writing and Speaking in the college regularly. The purpose behind these classes is to get opportunities of job to the learners.

3) Innovation in curricular design and transaction:

The Innovatives Activities are implemented always to develop the personalities of the students by all the respective Departments. All the departments plan out the Nature-Visit, the Study-Tour, the Industrial Tour, the Practical-Preparation Tour, the guest lectures, the historical Trips, the Educational Tour, the Environmental Tours, etc. from time to time to search out the talent of students towards research.

Our Principal, Dr. R.H.Gupta, has been framing the syllabi of Commerce and Economics U.G. and P G. in the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. He has been contributing nationally to the syllabi of Commerce in Other Universities. Some teachers have been recognized as the P.G. teachers by the University, though they are teaching at U.G. in the college. Some have been working as the paper setters for the syllabi of the University.

4) Inter disciplinary Programmes Started:

The college has started the classes of M.A. Economics during 2009-10. The college has been attempting the Career Oriented Course in Communication-Skills for developing the rural students of the Muktainagar Taluka. The Career Oriented Courses in Commerce for the students of FYBCOM were engaged with sincere efforts. The classes of M.Com have been carried out with sincerity and cooperation. So, the students have known the college like their own family.

5) Examination reforms implemented.

Unit Tests were conducted as per the units by the departments. Students' knowledge of the subject was assessed and practiced with these Tests. Prof. B.L.Mahajan and Prof. P.M. Sonwane carried out the activities of Examination of 10 marks of FYBA & FYBCOM which were taken in the first Semester of the University.

The college maintained the concept, No Copy Centre, Continuous practice tests were followed by the departments. The oral feedback on the taught syllabus was taken from the students from time to time. The Department of English gave awareness to

students on discipline, teaching and on character building while teaching in the classes. Prof L.B.Gayakawad, Head, Department of English emphasized his teaching with the religious touches; as a result, the students were turned into seriousness and maturity. They understood of studying regularly and being regular for the classes. The sober relation was observed among the girls and the boys students. They students were seen competent and happy in their studies. Counseling on the current issues was made to the students. This has been the internal strategy of the Department every year.

Home Assignments, Practical Activities, Project, the Internal Examination, the Group Discussion, the Seminars at, the Oral Feedbacks, the Question Round Method, the guest lecturers, etc. were considered honestly and the result was increasing. 23. Courses in which student-assessment of teacher is introduced & the action taken on students feed back:

As the college beings, the meeting is held under the supervision & guidance of the Principal. The Principal instructs all the Heads of the Department about holding their departmental meetings on the proper time. All the departments take their departmental meetings about the planning of syllabus and the administration towards the students. Thus, the teaching is done as per the decided conclusions in the meeting.

The Principal enquires of the syllabus in the monthly meeting. Teachers are shown their mistakes and guided towards students' uplift. Correcting the wrong teacher is transferred to the Heads of the Department and the Heads bring improvement to their teaching. Students are asked questions after teaching the topic concerned. Students are satisfied with this method. If students neglect, they are made aware on the proper time by the Heads and the Principal. Every department, thus, follows the oral feedback from their students to test them. This practice helps very much to the teachers to fill-up their self appraisal forms.

As a result, teachers have collected the rich feedbacks from their students. Revision of the topics is made for solving students' doubts. Group Discussion, Seminar, Practice Tests, etc. are conducted from time to time. The self Appraisal forms are filled up after the end of the syllabus-teaching as per the instructions of the Principal given in the monthly meeting. And, thus, the teacher's performances are assessed. If there are some suggestions of students, the Principal and the concerned Heads find out solutions on them and the teacher is corrected in his teaching. The meetings of the student's Council are also called on to maintain discipline and mutual understanding between teachers and students. This makes awareness among the teachers about attending periods regularly. We have got best result due to this strategy. The departments engage extra periods to

collect good self-appraisals from the students. The college has been a liking college of students in the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

The Institution has decided to surrender the Women Hostel to UGC. And from the next year, the indoor and out door stadiums, Girls Hostel and M.C.M etc. Projects are to be started newly. The proposals related have been sent about them to UGC. The tree-plantation has been implemented by the N.S.S. and the Earn and Learn Scheme students. The healthy aqua-guard water-system has been provided to the staff and the students. The third storey has been constructed to tend the students who are learning there. The college has decided to start gym-facility for the students and interested people of Muktainagar Taluka.

27. Technology up-gradation:

The college has developed the computer laboratory upgraded. The Institution has decided to extend the computer laboratory since next year. The online language laboratory is to be opened since-2010-11. We have the upgraded facilities like, "Intercom, Office Computerization, Internet, the Hardware with Advanced Software, etc." This up-gradation has influenced the staff members to work enthusiastically. This has been our remarkable feature to attract students to seek admission to the college.

28. Computer & internet access and training to teachers and students:

The commerce students learn their syllabus of the University with the computers in the computer laboratory. The teaching and the non teaching staff of the college and the students interested learn the computers in spare time under the guidance of Prof. S.A.Saindane from the Department of Commerce. Internet access is utilized for research and publication issues. We have created e-mails for every teacher. The emphasizing side is that the Principal always insists on operating computers. All the departments use the Internet access to collect the syllabus related if any. Some teachers have purchased their own computers to use the Internet access.

29. Financial aid to students:

The college is affiliated to the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The following financial aids are available in the college as per the rules of the University. 1) EBC Concession, 2) Merit Scholarship, a) National Merit Scholarship, b) Government Merit Scholarship, c) Free Ship to Children of High school Teachers, d) North Maharashtra University Students Welfare-Fund Scholarship. 3) Free Ship to Children of Freedom Freighters. 4) PTC for Children of Primary / Middle / High School Teachers, 5) National Scholarship, 6) College Student Free-Ship, 7) G.O.I. Scholarship to S.C./S.T/OBC Classes, 8) Once Failure Concession in Fees by Central Govt. to support SC/ST. Students, Maharashtra State Open Merit Scholarship for Students of all communities, 9) Savitribai Phule Chhatrapati Sahu Maharaj Scholarship.

The College Level Prizes:

The Principal has been giving the prize of Rs 501/- to the student stood first in T.Y.B.A. Examinations of Arts and Commerce. All the Heads of the departments have been giving the prizes of Rs 301/- each in their parents' names to the students stood first in the T.Y.B.A. Examination in their own departments.

30. Activities and support from the Alumni Association:

The college has maintained best relations with the Alumni. Adv. Shrikrushna Duttee, from Muktaingar Court attended the function of the Annual Social Gathering this year. Through Alumni, the college has kept proper relationship between the former students and the present students. The Alumni members utilize the library facilities if they need. The Alumni members help us in the activities of the Annual Social Gathering of the college every year. Through Yuvati Sabha of the college, the lady students are

invited with their mothers. Resp. Chandu Patil, our former student, from Muktaingar is now working as District President of Shivasena, and Member of Z.P.Jalgaon. The greatest benefit, we have collected from our Alumni is that they have guided our present students, have been enthusiastic towards life and education seeing their senior students' progress. Many of the Advocates in the Muktainagar Court are of the Dept. of English.

31. Activities and support from the parent teacher association:

We have maintained the concept of Family College; hence, we have family relations with our present and former students. This has been our goodwill in the area and parents run to seek admission of their sons and daughters to our college. Parents speak with respect about the college. The students are always submissive due to this. The mission of the Institution is to create ideal citizen to contribute to nation building, therefore, our Principal, Dr. R.H.Gupta maintains behavior with them with humanity. Hence, students call out the college as "Mother-Parent College." Parents are phoned, if some absence is maintained by students. Prof. S. B. Patil and Prof. P. M. Sonawane have been carrying out the activities of the Alumni to reach parents to balance relations.

32. Health Services:

Principal Resp. Dr. R. H. Gupta took rounds on the Pan-Parg-Gutkha, Tobacco chewing and ragging from time to time to give awareness to the students if any, to maintain the healthy atmosphere, in the college. He did counseling to the students through his addressing lectures at the time of the programmes of the departments.

This year, we carried out the Annual Social Gathering with distinctive arts sorts, Students religiously, educationally, socially and politically played roles.

The Yuvati Sabha Committee conducted "Personality Development Workshop" on the problems related to ladies on 15-1-2010 and thus, it was an effort to maintain health of the lady students. Prof. V. S. Lavhale carried out the responsibility successfully.

Prof .S. D. Patil Head, Deptt. Of Geography took out environmental tours on the pollution of the religious places. He tried, thus, to maintain health awareness among the students.

Prof V.S.Jadhav, Director of Physical Education carried out sport activities to make minds and bodies' sound to maintain health. The grounds were also upgraded to create Sportful atmosphere.

Prof. M. M. Chavan donated his blood on 19th Dec, 2009. His experience was utilized in the health activities of the college.

The N.S.S. Unit maintained the concept, “Through Cleanliness to Richness.” In the 7day Special Winter Camp at Chinchkheda, Tal.Muktainagar. He visited classes and counseled them on addictions like smoking, tobacco cheating regging and others.

The Department of English maintained brother-sister relation among the students consoling them socially and religiously. They were seen affected to know the cause of life as a result. ‘The Yuvati Sabha’ arranged some programmes on the counseling of the girls. Prof. Lavhale carried out responsibilities.

37. Placement services provided to students:

Students should write and speak English well, So, the extra periods / remedial classes on writing and speaking skills were taken regularly. The practice was made

towards the skill of writing and the skill of speaking. The practice passages were solved to make students speak & write grammatically. The art of writing was developed. It is compulsory to develop the skill of speaking with the writing-skill. In the extra-periods i.e. in the Remedial Classes” tenses, helping-verbs, conjunctions, propositions, articles, nouns, adjectives, adverbs, etc.” were taught and practiced from students. The objective test on this topic was conducted to support the activity. The students were given practice of English speaking phonetically. The proper change was seen among the students and that was pronounced by them also finally. The efforts were made by Prof. L.B.Gayakwad and Prof. Panchashil Waghmare.

38. Development programmes for non-teaching-staff:

The office-administration went through computers. The office-staff follows now all the activities with computers due to their practice in operating and the principal’s guidance and insistence on computer-learning. The staff learns computer operation under the guidance of the computer experts. The Principal and the office-Superintendent care the problems of the office-staff. The work-distribution is made by the Principal and the O.S. from time to time to maintain discipline among the office-administration. Inter-com system is maintained between the departments, and the office of the Principal. Monthly meetings for the non-teaching are held continuously by the Principal. They are instructed about their lapses during the meeting-span. Everyone is treated on the basis of humanity. But no one is spared of his duty, and, every one works with interest to develop the college.

39. Healthy Practices of the Institution:

The college is developing due to our family relations with students. Continuous extra periods are taken by Prof. L. B. Gayakwad from the Department of English for the needy and poor students. Other departments also take extra periods. If a teacher is on leave, his periods are adjusted by other teacher to stop wandering of the students in the campus. Annual Social Gathering, the cultural meet is celebrated every year to make presentation of culture through various programmes like songs, dramas and others. It makes students humanized. All the departments keep practice of practice-test, home-assignments, seminars, group discussion and others to make students zealous towards

their study. Guest lectures are conducted by the departments to make their students known to their life study.

Counseling is made from time to time, as a result, students are observed tension-free and lovers of life. Continuous Remedial Periods on Communication Skill on Grammar are taken regularly by Prof. L. B. Gayakwad in the Department of English.

Seminars and Group Discussion are carried out by all the departments. Parents are kept in well relation to develop students. Some strange events of the students are solved under the guidance of the students.

Related Association are inaugurated by all the departments and the activities are implemented in the departments as per the objectives declared.

Educational Trips, Nature Visit, Industrial Visits, Projects, etc. are carried out during every session. Students are motivated and progressed through the publication of the Annual Magazine of the college every year. The writing of the students creates social awareness among them. Teachers upgrade the students' knowledge in the beginning using some periods for the Bridge Courses.

We have kept the concept of "no-copy centre" in the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Cleanliness and plantation activities are cared out from time to time.

Practice Test are rewritten from the students and if they don't pay attention, awareness letters are collected from parents signed by them in the Department of English. The annual examination result has increased to 90-95 % every year as a result. Students are recalled about their skills of writing and speaking English well from time to time.

The birth and death anniversaries of the social workers like Resp. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar & Resp. Dr. Radha Krishnan are celebrated as a small attempt to make students known to community service. Students invite guest lecturer themselves to celebrate these activities. National Awareness runs in the spirit of Students thus.

The Multi-Purpose Hall is built to celebrate the activities of the college in it. The outside-agencies also use it to celebrate their activities.

A Grand-Blood-Donation Camp in respect of the birthday of Her Excellency, Sau. Pratibhatai Patil, President of India is organized every year. Women Health-Check-up, Addiction Relief and Aids Awareness are carried out successfully.

The college celebrates every year the cultural meet, 'The Annual Social Gathering'. Sports, Debating, Poetry-Reading, Exhibition, Rangoli, Anand Mela, Traditional Dress; etc. competitions are held to progress the students.

Curricular activities are promoted. The departmental meetings are called upon to administer the departmental teaching. The college ground is made available to the players from outside societies in the evenings.

Prof. B. L. Mahajan has been creating awareness of cleanliness and health as he has been given the responsibility.

The committees formed carry out student oriented activities. The former students use the books and the reference books from the library of the college.

The Principal has joined the teaching and the non-teaching staffs in the understanding of maturity to build the goals of the Institution.

The Principal persuades and promotes the staff for updating their knowledge related.

The student is considered a centre and everything is done in the college around him/her.
