### **Women's Hostel:**

Muktainagar, educationally and economically backward Taluka, is situated on the outskirts of Madhya Pradesh. Being such, it has been going through famine with the consequences like poverty and lack of education. It doesn't have an industrial background. Farming and non-irrigated area remain only the source of lively hood. Such a situation makes difficult for Girls to take education in the big cities like Jalgaon & Bombay. Hence, the Girls' Hostel becomes helpful to Girls' education in the Muktainagar Taluka and in some of the areas of the Buldhana District & the Jalgaon District areas. Because of the problems of place, we have surrendered the Girls' Hostel to U.G.C. and decided to build Girls' Hostel separately, because, the first Girls' Hostel was on the 2<sup>nd</sup> storey of the college building and the girls were not safety there.

### **Centre for coaching for competitive Examination:**

Without social life, the Institution remains meaningless. Hence, social needs are man's life. And without Progressing students, we cannot collect our goals and missions. Therefore, to develop students, we hold the regular classes on competitive examination. This becomes an attempt to boost student to enter the examinations like M.P.S.C. & U.P.S.C. Personality development is made through guest lectures and workshops. This practice creates a spirit among students and they join the classes of M.P.S.C., U.P.S.C. either in Jalgaon, Pune or Bombay. Many of the students have sought services in the cities like Pune & Bombay. The Multi- knowledge books are provided to the students to mould their characters to the substantial frame. The General-knowledge committee organizes the classes as per the schedule framed. Different experienced teachers & professors are invited to teach and guide on the general issues of the world. Resp. Dr R.H. Gupta, former Registrar of the North Maharashtra and Our Principal gets interested to organize some personality development workshops & invites some personalities from Jalgaon. He sends students to different competitions held at the University level. The significant thing is that the University has also prescribed the syllabus of and this continuous practice helps many students to appear for the examinations. We have been taking the general Knowledge classes from the beginning of the college.

### **Personality Development:**

Educationally & Economically undeveloped Muktainagar Taluka provides us very many weak and disabled students for education. So Marathi as well as English becomes a problem of their learning. All the departments teach them carefully and guide on their future to remove their disabilities.

In this computerized world, nothing moves ahead without English background. Taking this into consideration, Writing & speaking English prove very challenging in the case of such students. Hence, the department of English engages Extra Classes to improve their communication-skills. While teaching, the stress is giving on the writing & speaking skills. It won't be exaggerated that the disabled students climb up to the destination of their success. The periods as per the time-table & the extra periods assist the English Department to improve the annual results of the examinations. Commerce and Economics Departments also arrange Extra periods. Hence, the students are satisfied with the teaching as the attraction to seek admission to our college. Principal, Dr. R. H. Gupta and the Management insist on improving the teaching. The results of all the departments, hence, have gone to 80 % and maximum of the subjects bring 100% of result in the University Examination.

From this year, the college has started the Certificate Course in Speak English with Grammar & Phonology. The Department of English engaged the periods on developing the writing and the speaking skills with the practice of the phonology skills.

Seminars, Home assignments, & projects were given to them to bring out results. Finally, as per the University letter, the examination of 300 marks was conducted at college level. The Question – papers were set at the college. There were 3 subjects carrying 100 marks each. The paper was: 1) Basic of Grammar; 2) Initial Preparation of Phonology; 3) Project & Practical. The Certificates will be given to the students by the University on submitting the result to them. Finally, it was observed that the students were speaking and writing the structure of English according to Grammar & Phonology. It helps students to seek Jobs for their life.

As a result, many of the students of the College have sought Jobs in the social walks of Life. These courses have helped students to seek admission to the English Department. Other Departments have also developed students who have got services outside in life. All the departments implement the projects, home assignments group discussion; seminars & hence now, the college has been popular in comparison with the previous stages of the students strength.

The department of commerce has been running the Career Oriented Courses in the field of Jobs. The teacher also have been teaching syllabus honestly, hence also, the strength of students have increased.

The Department of Economics engages Extra Classes for the needy and the Disabled students. Our principal has been very much inspiring personality and the main source of the college activities. He has developed the college from the educational level to the infrastructural level. The infrastructure in the college is only due to his sincere efforts to the institution. The educational progress is in process due to his sincere guidelines to the teaching – staff. The college computerization is a result of his labour continuously.

The separate reading rooms are there for girls, boys and the staff. Former students are served with the books they want. The principal has been trying to make the library well – reformed considering the global issues.

### **Promotion of Research:**

The innovative strategies are carried out through nature Visit, industrial Visit, the Environmental Science – Field tour, Education Trip, etc. to make students known to the research activity. Projects are prepared by all the departments to promote the research of their students.

The Principal discusses all the times about the promotion of research. No meeting is held without stressing on the promotion of research. He has instructed the staff about research. Hence, the teachers have rushed ahead to present their papers at National and International Levels.

The daily News Paper, Deshdut from Jalgaon has published his 100 Articles in Marathi on various themes of social life.

The college organized the Annual social gathering- the cultural meet on the same ground and the listener from the societies were entertained by the college students. It was our sincere attempt to make students social with roles they performed.

The multi – purpose Hall is used to conduct all the cultural activities of the college. The Hall has built the personalities of students & teachers. This year also the Zilla Parishad Primary section conducted their 4<sup>th</sup> standard Scholarship Examinations in our college. The N.S.S. unit & the Earn & Learn scheme have followed the tree plantation. The Aqua- Guard Water system has been provided to the stake holders. The classes are held on the third floor constructed newly. The Vidya Bharati Welfare and the Sports Club have been founded in the college to develop the students who are educationally mentally and physically disabled. The periods on General Knowledge were engaged by the Committee formed. The sincere attempt behind them is to turn students to the study of the M.P.S.C. & the U.P.S.C. Examinations.

The students were counseled religiously and socially by the departmental of English to maintain brother- sister relation and the atmosphere of the nation building. They were observed sincerely affected as a result. All the teachers maintained regularity in counseling from time to time. The girls were counseled about their issues related by organizing some activities.

The activities on the National Heroes were practiced by the Departments. The Principal took rounds permanently to emphasis on the discipline. He put Tulasi plants in the corners that the students won't spit upon the walls.

The patriotic songs are sung by the college students at the time of the Annual social gathering of the College to create the spirit of Nation- building among them.

The programmes on the National Heroes are organized to make the students think over the serious and social issues of the nation.

The N.S.S. unit implements the activities to create social awareness among the students. The students know the real purpose of national service and their own duties of families & life.

The Department of physical Education follows such games through which the students know the importance of their bodies and duties towards the Nation-building.

The library staff creates awareness of reading among the students & the students read the various books.

The cultural cell of the college every year prepares the students for the cultural activities & they learn “freedom equality and fraternity” through the programmes connected.

The students are made silent and promising thorough the organization of the environmental tours nature visits, educational trips, social economical and educational surveys, industrial tours, projects, home assignments, seminars, group discussions, fed backs, practice/ unit test etc.

### **37. Placement Services Provided to Students:**

The students should be progressed for himself and for society. He should earn his own service, hence, we started the certificate course in “Speak English with Grammar & Phonology” The students started to write and speak simple structures of English.

Career Guidance committee has been formed out to open the ways of services to the students of the college. This committee guides the students on the education after graduation to welcome various opportunities to services. Prof Santanu Vashisht from College of Engineering & Technology, Bambhori, Jalgaon guided on the personality development. It was a day’s workshop on the service- opportunities. He made available the opportunities of the campus interviews for our students at his college.

### **38. Developmet Programmes for Non – Teaching Staff:**

The Non- teaching staff has been working with the computers. Every-body has learnt operating computer due to the inspiration of the Principal. The Experts are called on about the software – operation. The problems of the office- staff are considered and solved by the Principal and the Office- Superintendent. The work is distributed by the O.S. under the Principal’s guidance. Inter- Com system is used for communication. Monthly Meetings are held by the Principal to update the staff. Humanity is followed for relation but no one is speared of the duty. Every one works with inspiration & enthusiasm. The work of the Examination, the scholarship, the payment of the staff and the work related are carried out with the computers. The total non- teaching staff goes through the computer proceedings.



### **39. Healthy Practices of the Institution:**

The college maintains the family relations with the students without partiality. Continuous extra coaching is done by the department of English. While teaching in the class, Teaching- Items of Grammar are found out and are taught and practiced to improve the writing and the speaking skills of the students. It covers all the teaching with counseling about the social, religious & humanistic point of view. If the students quit the periods, the parents are conveyed on phones. Absence for the periods is controlled smoothly and hence no student remains absent without permission.

Oral feed backs about the teaching are taken by the teachers in the class, so, the teaching becomes healthy to update the students. Every problem of these students is solved with affection.

The Department of Economics & the Department of Commerce also engage the Extra coaching i.e. the Remedial aching Classes. All the subjects have given the best results every year. The teachers control the absence of the Teachers on leave by engaging his periods for his own teaching, and hence, the wandering of the students is controlled. Engaging periods is valued very much. So, the students seek admission to the college. Students are humanized by arranging the social programmers on the lives of the national men and women. Students are made industrious by the Departments by arranging the practice / Unit Tests Home assignments, seminars, Group Discussions, Projects; nature visits; Educational trips, etc, Gust Lectures of the Experts are engaged for updating the subject Knowledge. The Language lab is brought into use for developing the Communication skills of the Students. The training and guidance about placement is made by the committee.

Sincere needs of the students are granted without delay by the Principal. Suggestion box is put for the convenient instructions of the students and parents. Parents are kept in contact always about the students' problems. Contributions periods on General Knowledge are engaged on every Saturday. Students' meetings are called on by the Principal to maintain discipline in the teaching and Cultural schedules of the college. No student is neglected in the college up to his graduation. All the departmental activities are carried out as per the objectives of the Association inaugurated. College activities are implemented as per the Academic calendar. Departmental Meetings are held to Maintain Discipline in the Departmental administration. Every Department is strict on controlling absence of the students for the Teaching Classes. Roll Calls & Academic Diaries are maintained to bring sincerity in the teaching – process. Students are considered for the library facilities.

Sportsmen & sports women are valued for their convenient needs. Students are made submissive and social minded through the N.S.S. activities. The separate Cultural Cell is opened for developing the cultural phases of the students' life. The Yuvati Sabha Cell is working for vindicating the girl's problems & needs.

The college magazine is published every year to shine the hidden corners of the student's personality. The bridge courses are engaged to push students ahead. Cleanliness & plantation Drives are run from time to time. Our 'No copy Center' concept has given the college the best identification. Unit tests are rewritten by the departments. The letters signed by the parents are taken by the Department of English if they miss the activity. Students celebrate the anniversaries of the National Heroes on their own accord with the permissions of the principal. Hence, the self – responsibility is created among them. The outside agencies use the college building and the multipurpose hall for their activities. The activities on social awareness are organized by the N.S.S. Department. Curricular activities are promoted always by the principal. The teachers are motivated towards their research, conferences, and orientation & refresher courses. The college ground is utilized by the players from the society. The former students are called to celebrate the departmental activities. The different committees have been formed to channelize the students' oriented activities.
