**Part A:**

The Local IQAC has prepared the action plan to strengthen quality and to receive results during the academic year 2011-12 to consider over the next objectives:

To implement new courses to make student able to know horizontal mobility.

To organize excursion to educationally and academically relevant places to achieve an idea of advancement in the students-study.

To follow the objectives shown in part 'C' of the AQAR (2010-2011).

To maintain social awareness with superb care for the extension activities organized by the college.

To support guest lectures, workshops, seminars, group discussions on eminent themes and issues stressing the social and educational purposes.

**Women's Hostel:**

Muktainagar, being educationally and economically background Taluka, goes through draughts where there is no industrial background. The total area is rural, farming and non-irrigated. Therefore, girls cannot attend the colleges at Jalgaon, Pune and Bombay. Women's Hostel has been the need of the time for Girls' education where girls come from the Districts of Jalgaon and Buldhana. The total construction cost of the Hostel is 1,12,31,067/-and the UGC has sanctioned 60 lacs. The Institution has commenced to construct the building of Women Hostel on the land adjacent to the college campus and the work is in progress.

**Center for coaching for Competitive Examination:**

To fulfill our goals and mission, we always progress our students with the help of the classes of Competitive Examination. This attempt boosts them to follow the examinations like M.P.S.C AND U.P.S.C. and other related competitive examinations like Police Dept and Banking. Students' personalities are earned thus organizing the guest lectures and regular workshops. As a result, students have sought admissions to the

famous academies of competitive examinations in Jalgaon, Nashik, Pune and Bombay. The various books are made available to them to shine their qualities in the computerized market outside. Every year, the regular competitive classes are held by the committee according to the schedule framed. Our dearest Principal, Dr. R.H.Gupta takes more interest to invite the eminent guest teachers from the academies of Jalgaon, the district place. Students are sent regularly to attend competitive activities at University and National level by him. The most significant thing is that the North Maharashtra University has also prescribed the syllabus of Competitive Exams. This also makes students competitive. Our college has been organizing the competitive classes from its beginning. The continuous lecture series in this regard has increased our student's strength in the General Knowledge field and they have acquired their services in the walks of life.

#### **Personality Development:**

Under the guidance of the Principal, every department brings 80 to 100 % results every year.

This is the second year of the Certificate Course in "Speak English with Grammar and Phonology". The building of students' character was done with seminars, home-assignments, and projects. Finally the academic year, three papers carrying 100 marks each, were

conducted and the result was sent to the parent University to secure certificates against it. These certificates and our labour were fruitful to students to get their services in the competitive world.

The continuous extra classes of the Departments made students industrious and serious to know the basic of their life, as a result, they got services in the society out side. The Department of English has been favourite due to this attempt, the Career Oriented Courses. Maximum of the students of the Department have got services with this laborious strategy. Every department goes through Home-Assignments, Seminars, Projects, Group Discussion, etc. and the students are built honestly, so, the college has got popularity comparing with the previous strength of students.

His 07 English poems have been published by the international journals, Poetcrit, Maranda, H.P.and Kafla, Chandighr. The Minor Research Projects of Prof.B.L.Mahajan, Prof R.L.Kachhawa Dr. J.B.More and Prof. S.K.Mali have been sanctioned. The students participated in Research Activities, "Avishkar" of the parent University.

## **Part B:-**

### **1) Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:-**

The examination of 300 marks was held as per the guide-lines of the Parent University in the first week of May. The University will

issue certificates against these 300 marks. These courses, being career oriented, have supported students to seek their services outside and have brought encouragement to the weaker and disabled students.

### **3) Innovation in Curricular Design & Transaction:**

Principal, Dr. R.H.Gupta is working on curricular design committees in the Parent University. He has been bringing innovation in curricular design and transactions. Many of the teachers have been assigned the University works like paper setting, evaluation, flying squad, etc. Many of the faculty has been recognized as P.G .teachers. Prof. L. B. Gayakwad, Head, Dept. of English was appointed as a Guest Lecturer for M.A. English Classes by Arts, Commerce and Science College, Jamner. Prof. B. L. Mahajan worked as a Local CAP Director to implement the examination of FYBA and B.Com Sem-I & II. To mould students to curricular oriented, the activities of ‘study Tour, Industrial Tour, Practical Preparation, Guest Lectures, Historical Trips, Educational / Nature Visit, Environmental Tour, etc. have been implemented by the departments.

The course of BCA was successfully run by the college. Department of Economics conducted M.A. Classes regularly. Certificate Course in “Speak English with Grammar and Phonology” was run sincerely by the Department of English. Thirty one students appeared for the examination of this course as per the Parent University. All the departments gave good results subject wise.

Practice Tests / Unit Tests were conducted to increase students’ subject knowledge to face successfully annual examination. The Committee headed by Prof. B. L. The continuous regular periods, extra periods, practice tests and counseling changed students into industrious, hence, they were not attracted by copy. Feedbacks from the students were collected. The stress was given always on discipline, teaching and the character building of the students. Family and religious background made students serious in learning and teaching. There was the distinct relation between girls and



students. This healthy climate attracts parents to seek admission of their sons and daughters to our college.

**23. Courses in which student-assessment of teacher is introduced & the action taken on students feed back:**

The heads are instructed in the meeting to take departmental meetings regarding the syllabus planning. The teaching is carried out as per the calendar formed. The Principal take a review of the teachers in the monthly meetings taking student into consideration. Heads of the departments implement changes in teaching of the staff. #### **26. Increase in the infrastructural facilities:**

The constructions of the Women Hostel and Sports indoor stadium are under process. The Earn and Learn Scheme and the N.S.S. Unit have done tree-plantation in the campus around. The aqua-guard water system has been improved. There are separate cells and departments to carry out activities smoothly. The Vidya Bharati Welfare and the sport clubs have been developing students educationally, mentally and physically. The ultra-modern facilities Virtual Class Room has been constructed to make students acquainted with the information / lecture running outside in Pune or Bombay. It means,

they avail the knowledge facility available in India sitting only in the Virtual Classroom in the college. The college students and outsiders have been using the Health club facilities run by the college. The college playground is made available to the college students and the players from the societies to play “Volley-ball, ball-badminton, Kabaddi and Kho-Kho”. The college has developed the central laboratory of 30 students for the students of Commerce and B.C.A. The students of F.Y.S.Y. and T.Y.B.Com & B.C.A. prepare their practical theory and other related activities in this laboratory. Practical theory is conducted for 2 hours.

The students of Department of English and other college students have been utilizing the Language Lab for developing their skills of Language, English. They develop their Listening, Speaking, Writing, Reading i.e. Communication-Skills of English language. They were given practical on the Communication skills by Prof Panchashila. A. Prof. L.B.Gayakwad trained students in the Communication Skills through teaching the syllabus of the Career Oriented Course “Speak English with Grammar and Phonology” as per the Parent University and sent to the Language Lab to practice the Communication Skills with the help of the software available.

Moreover, the total college has the WiFi system. There is a LCD Display to display the information related with the students and the staff. The Departments use LCD while teaching their students. The institution has set the Safety Cameras to control students to maintain discipline and to keep watch over the routine administration of the college related with the teachers and other staff.

### **27. Technology up-gradation:**

The college has the upgraded computer laboratory of 30 computers to update the students of commerce and B.C.A. There is a Language Laboratory to upgrade the college students in the communication-skills of English. The students learn English Language online. Intercom, office computerization, Internet i.e. total WiFi system, hardware with the advanced software, etc are made available. This enthusiastic attempt has increased the student’s source of the college.

## **28. Computer & internet access and training to teachers and students:**

The teachers get trained in computers in spare time under the guidance of Prof. S.A. Saindane. The students are trained in computers while they learn their practical and theory of their university subjects. The Internet Access is open for research and publication issues.
