To cherish the needs of the students, the college has proposed to run the classes of experts for the competitive examinations like M.P.S.C and U.P.S.C. It is happy to say that the college has been running lectures on general knowledge since 1990 and as a result, we have seen our students successful in the walks of life with a daring to face different examinations in the field of competitive world.

**Personality development:**

Our students though come from rural area, they have been very much hard working in their subjects prescribed by the university. They have brought the bright success in the annual examinations, as a result, the ratios of passing and merit have been observed above 75% in every subject. If such students haven't the capacity of communicating in English and even in related subjects, they never fulfil the purpose of ideal citizens in the world of globalization. Therefore, the college has sent a proposal to U.G.C. to start the Oriented Course of Communicative skills in English especially. The Department of English has been running the English Speaking classes since the beginning as an aid to the activity. The proposal for the oriented courses like "Taxation, Auditing, Income Tax, Photography and Computer Programming has also been sent to UGC and the college has been trying to persue them. The excellent two lectures of and our Principal, Dr. Gupta, former Registrar of the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon were arranged by the Commerce & Arts faculty respectively. Group discussion was also held under his guidance and supervision sincerely. The principal emphasized the brilliant issues really related to the personality- development of the students and even the staff members. The students gave good preference and response. The principal has been

counseling them from time to time. Every year our General Knowledge Committee conducts the activities and lectures of experts on the competitive examinations to shape their personalities. This year, Sunil Ahire, B.D.O. of Muktainagar has delivered a good lecture to our students. The activities of counseling, Yuvati Sabha, Nature Club, Departmental Associations, Alumni, Former Students Faculty, Gandhi Peace Centre, Library, Sports, N.S.S., Earn and Learn Scheme, Environmental Science, Visits to Small industries, Educational Trips have been carried out by the departments at their level to flourish the students personalities.

#### **Enrichment of Library:**

Library is called the storehouse of Knowledge and this treasure highlights the corners of students and the world is brought very close to learners. Academic progress remains handicapped without the references available in the library. There fore the college has purchased 1350 books of Re 2,49,504/- and 55 Journals & Magazines of Rs. 35,810/- with 11 cupboards of Rs 50,600/- to enrich it. The variety of these books has been very much helping and progressive for the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff. And the increases in number of Journals have been the asset of the library to be utilized by the users.

#### **Promotion of Research:**

To develop the students and the working staff through promotion of research means to attempt for improving the standard of community related to the Institution. One teacher is doing his work on Ph.D. and others are trying for following the process. The college has decided to give top priority to the demands of the teachers about purchasing books and the related equipment.

As a result of it, Prof P.M.Pawar, Head Department of Political Science has been awarded Ph.D. by the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, on the subject of "The Political Participation of Banjara Community: An Analytical Study".

##### **1. Activities reflecting the goals & objectives of the Institution:**

The institution aims at producing ideal citizens to progress communities related and students are the main means to try to go such a way. ## **2. New Academic Programmes Initiated ( U.G.P.G.)**

## **3. Innovation in curricular design and transaction:**

Our college is affiliated to North Maharashtra university, Jalgaon and hasn't an autonomy of designing curriculum of its own. And the curricula are up dated by the university as per the need of time and are implemented by the college. Dr R.H.Gupta, our Principal and Former Registrar of the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon has contributed to the syllabus of U.G.and P.G.in different University as state level. Our staff member, Dr P.M.Pawar has also contributed to the syllabus framing of Political Science and Public Administration at University level. Our staff members have got the recognition as P.G. teachers. They have contributed to setting the papers of their respective subjects.

## **4. Inter disciplinary programmes started:**

The college has determined to make available the horizontal mobility to flourish the students of Arts & Commerce in the academic discipline. Therefore, the proposal for the following oriented courses has been sent to U.G.C.

The college had sent the proposal to the university to start Marathi Special at P.G. level for the students of Arts and M.Com at P.G. Level for the students of Commerce. The university has sanctioned an M.Com and so, the college has decided to start M.Com. from the year, 2007-2008. This effort of the college has been fruitful for the students of commerce because they shan't need to go to the district place to seek admission for M.Com.

## **1. Examination reforms implemented:**

The North Maharashtra University Jalgaon prescribes syllabi in the college.

The syllabi must be prepared in benefit of students, therefore, regular unit tests and terminal examinations are conducted by the departments. Practice test of the 100 marks is also conducted finally the academic year. The subject teachers, for the weaker and needy students manage oral feedback and revision of the difficult topics considering continuous assessment programmes. The departments maintain seminar, group-discussion, feedback, etc. If the students remain absent, their parents are conveyed through the letters, which are got signed by them.

To make students sincere in education and social duty. The counseling is provided for ladies students and students touching the problems like “alcoholic tobacco, rural problems and other related social aspects.” All the teachers counsel them, on proper time. Thus, the counseling has created an eye of discipline among the students.

Home-assignments, the project works on the syllabus, visits to the small-industries, the preparation of the practical examination of 20 marks prescribed by the university are implemented. If mistakes are observed in their working, the proper suggestions are given to them to achieve the sincere result. The subject knowledge test brings a good result for every department to check out the progress of every student in his study.

### 32) Health Services:

The college conducted the following health services.
